



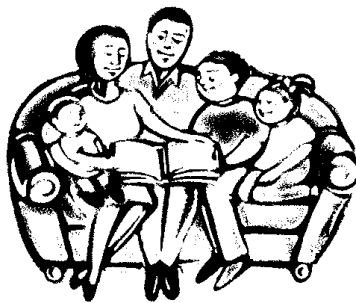
WHAT MIGHT A BOOK OF FAITH HOUSEHOLD LOOK LIKE?

Families might decide to spend time in conversation with Scripture on a regular basis whether that is daily or weekly. One model for such a conversation is:

- ❖ Gather together and share where you saw God at work that day/week
- ❖ Choose a passage from the Bible to read out loud – you can use the lessons for the week or follow some other reading guide such as the ones in the Lutheran Study Bible or ELW or Synod web site
- ❖ See if you can find a picture that illumines the passage on <http://www.textweek.com/art/art.htm>
- ❖ Ask each family member what they see in the picture and/or what they heard in the passage
- ❖ Close with a prayer asking God to watch over your family and over the world.
